# Criteria

- **Innovation:**
  - An implementation of the project must have taken place and the ways in which it is innovative and different from other e-learning implementations should be described.
- **Pedagogy:**
  - The project must clearly demonstrate the involvement of a pedagogical idea or educational objectives.
- **Technology:**
  - the choice of technology must be explained as well as how this technology gives an added value to the specific teaching and learning activities.
- **Usefulness and benefits of the innovation**
  - Applicants must submit some form of evidence of the benefits

- Feb: Shortlisting
- May: Final judging
- June: Award winner is announced at  
EUNIS 2008
- July: Evaluation of the scheme
